## FOOD PACKAGING IN A LOCAL FOOD BANK

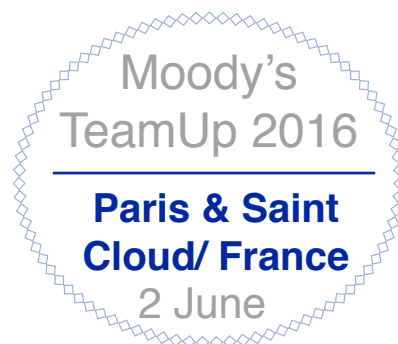
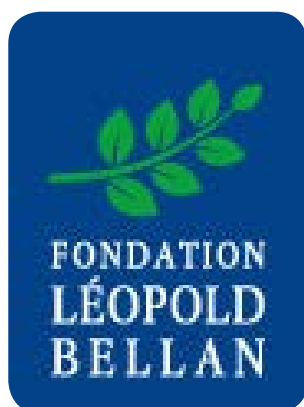
