Join local volunteers to discover how they protect nature, preserve heritage, and promote cycling. Volunteering Equality Note: Active tour, ensure you wear suitable clothing and walking shoes. **Rights Action** Bicycles are provided. Organisations: Natuurpunt Mechels Rivierengebied, Despot Rato (Museum Hof van Busleyden, Stadsarchief Mechelen, Het Predikheren, Projecten en Monumenten, and Erfgoedcel Mechelen), Cyclists' Union. Study visit 2: Circular Economy and Elderly Care looking into learning about the power of sharing and community care. See how volunteers create a vibrant environment for the elderly and promote a circular economy through tool, bicycle, and seed libraries. Note: During this visit, you will also have the opportunity to chat with the residents and volunteers and participate in a game of pétanque! Organisations: Deelbaar Mechelen, Residential care center Hof Van Egmont. 2ND APR • Study visit 3: Circular Human Work and Cultural Connection experiencing the world of sustainable living and inclusive art. Discover how volunteers combat food waste and foster creativity for individuals with disabilities. Note: Short transfer of 15 minutes to the second organization. Organisations: La Luna, Foodsavers Mechelen, Sjarabang vzw. Study visit 4: Exploring the Vibrant Neighborhood 'Heihoek' and mARTa and seeing how residents are revitalizing their community. Learn about grassroots efforts in culture, greening, and social cohesion including the transformation of a historic church into a cultural hotspot. Note: Active tour, walk along various stops in the neighborhood. Organizations: Heihoek neighborhood, mARTa. Study visit 5: Present and Past: Heritage and Culture to reach a better understanding of the beautifully restored monastery-library and the city • archives. See how volunteers are preserving and sharing the city's rich heritage, making it accessible to all. Organisations: Predikheren, City Archives of Mechelen. Study visit 6: See how a neglected youth site was transformed into a thriving hub. Learn about youth-led initiatives, circus arts, and the power of community collaboration. Discover how volunteers are creating spaces for young people to flourish. Note: Dress for possible rain and wear comfortable shoes; it is about a twenty-minute walk from the center. **<u>Organizations</u>**: Transit M, Circolito, youth department of the City of Mechelen, youth council. Study visit 7: Learn how volunteers are providing access to cultural experiences for elderly residents, and how others are using bicycle cabs to promote sustainable mobility, supporting the elderly, and the climate at the same time. Note: Session accessible for less mobile people, no walking included. Organizations: Vier het Leven, Klimavelo (Klimaan vzw). Study visit 8: Explore how Mechelen residents are addressing global challenges locally. Learn about sustainable development goals, initiatives for accessible vision care, and the vital role of senior citizen advocacy. Note: A 20-minute walk there and a 20-minute walk back. Organisations: Mechelen's Global Council, Refaced and Eyes for the World, Mechelen Senior Council. • Study visit 9: Embark on a self-guided audio tour to discover Mechelen's commitment to diversity and inclusion. Learn about local initiatives promoting equal opportunities and experience the city through a new perspective. Note: Bring a mobile phone, internet connection, and earphones. You can follow the tour in both Dutch and English. The walk is 6 kilometers long; comfortable shoes are recommended.
