Gdansk, Gorizia, Izmir and Madrid Municipalities join the “European Volunteering Capital Candidates Community” (EVCCC), a unique Community of Practice of municipalities (and other levels of local and regional authorities) that have expertise in, and a shared concern for, strengthening, inspiring and celebrating VOLUNTEERING and SOLIDARITY.
