Background information: CEV is looking for two European Solidarity Corps members legally resident in Belgium to be part of a 8 month EVS project in Osijek (Croatia) focused on the integration of refugees and asylum seekers.

The position offered is full time for 8 months. All expenses and costs are covered by the project and full training will be given. Candidates should be members of the European Solidarity Corps (registered in the ESC portal).

Priority will be given to participants with fewer opportunities: young people with cultural differences, young people with economic, social and geographical obstacles. **Unfortunately, due to architectural barriers, we are not able to involve people with physical disabilities.**

Main tasks:

- Implementing social activities towards integration of refugees and asylum seekers;
- support to school youth volunteering clubs;
- promotion of ESC/EVS;
- organizing and implementing different volunteer actions, manifestations and events in the community;
- administrative tasks in VCOS;
- language courses for local volunteers and other interested citizens

Requirements and competencies:

- Legal residency in Belgium
- Basic knowledge of refugee situation in Europe
- Willingness to learn
- Reliability and flexibility
- Communication and writing skills in English
- Capability in adapting to different conditions
- Creativity and Good problem solving skills
- Team player

Note: Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interviews.
